## **CHILD ABDUCTIONS ABROAD**

If your child was taken to another country without your consent contact the following agencies to assist in securing their return:

- 1) Office of Children's Issues, United States Department of State (1-800-407-4747)
- 2) Federal Bureau of Investigation, TN, file a missing person report and have the child's name entered into NCIC (901-747-4300)
- 3) Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, CIU (615-744-4000)
- 4) Kentucky State Police (502-564-1020)
- 5) Federal Bureau of Investigation, KY, filing a missing person report and have the child's name entered into NCIC (502-263-6000)

What the State Department Can Do:

- They can provide you with information about various resources that may assist you in your efforts to return your child to the United States;
- If your child is abducted to a country that is a Hague Abduction Convention partner country, they can accept your Hague application and monitor developments concerning your child's case through the Foreign Central Authority;
- They can provide a list of attorneys in the country where your child is located;
- They can answer questions from local and federal law enforcement about the Department's role in international child abduction cases;
- They can facilitate your communication with other U.S. government agencies and non-governmental organizations that may be able to assist you.

If you can, gather the following documents to assist these agencies: copy of marriage certificate, copy of child's birth certificate, color photographs of child, written description of your child (height, weight, hair/eye color, birthmarks, etc), copy of child's social security card, copy of US Passport, school records, medical records, and court documents relating to child and marriage.
