Drive/Operator (Kabul Afghanistan)

Major Duties: As a driver/operator, he/she is assigned to drive and operate firefighting vehicles of significant complexity engaged in structural firefighting, rescue, and Hazardous Materials (HAZMAT) Operations and assist in reducing and/or eliminating potential fire hazards and reacting to the presence or potential releases of hazardous materials as a first responder to protect persons, property, or the environment.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Performs hazard and risk assessment techniques in completing initial incident analysis
- Drives to the scene of the fire following a predetermined route or selecting an alternate when necessary and positions vehicle considering factors, such as wind direction, sources of water, hazards from falling structures, etc
- Operates pumps, foam generators, and other similar equipment
- Determines proper pressures, the number of lines, and relays requirements to the booster pumper
- Maintains constant awareness of levels in self-contained breathing apparatus and warns other firefighters when tanks are close to empty
- Assists in training other firefighters on driving vehicles and operating equipment
- Performs structural firefighting duties for a variety of facilities, which may include large multistoried buildings, industrial areas, and/or base storage facilities
- Performs rescue of personnel and a variety of first aid measures to alleviate further injury and prepare the victim(s) for transport to a medical facility
- Maintains firefighting equipment and fire station facilities and complies with health, safety, and environmental rules and procedures performing work in a manner that enhances the safety of the work environment

Qualifications: Personnel must meet the qualification requirement using experience alone--no substitution of education for experience is permitted.

- Specialized experience is defined as: Experience of all phases of fire department operations, i.e. structural, crash/fire/rescue, hazardous material **and Basic Life Support medical services.**

Personnel must meet the following qualifications:

- Must maintain a valid State driver's license **and an Emergency Vehicle Operators certification.**
- Must have and be able to maintain the **following Firefighter Certifications: Firefighter II (includes Firefighter I), HAZMAT Awareness, HAZMAT Operations, Apparatus Driver Operator- Pumper and ARFF vehicles, Apparatus Driver Operator- Mobile Water Supply (MWS)**
- The position is subject to immediate recall and extended shifts during emergencies
- The work of this position **requires a SECRET Security clearance.**
- This position requires the employee to work under adverse environmental conditions and falls under the respiratory protection program and hearing conservation program.
- Employee is required to report for duty during Natural Disasters or such emergency situations.

Certification Requirement: Certifications must have been awarded by the Department of Defense (DOD) or any equivalent entity accredited by International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) or Pro-Board.
