Electrician

Under general supervision, installs, maintains, and repairs airport building and airfield electrical systems, facilities, and equipment.

Performs preventative maintenance inspections and tests on, and maintains and repairs motors, relays, circuit breakers, and other electrical components of the lighting and mechanical systems in all airport/airfield related facilities; installs, and modifies and repairs such systems; performs of monitors contractor repair work on computer system, access control system, public address system and fire alarm system.

Maintains runway, taxiway, beacons, weather monitoring systems, and other special airport lighting systems in accordance with codes, standards, and other requirements.

Assists in inspecting the contract maintenance/repair/installation of electrical facilities and developing improvements to such facilities.

Education equivalent to graduation from high school and four year industrial electrical apprenticeship program. Knowledge of local, state, and federal codes pertaining to electrical facilities and equipment. Minimum of two years of maintenance electrician experience

Must possess a valid Tennessee Driver's License; must obtain and maintain SIDA (Security Identification Display Area) and AOA (Airport Operations Area) clearance. Must obtain and maintain Ramp and AOA driving privileges within first six months of employment.
