**Key Role:**

Prepare observations and recommendations to installation leadership and staff, assist the team lead with preparing and delivering briefing materials, and collaborate with active duty and civil service government staff, counterparts across Army organizations, and other government agencies. Perform in multiple program areas, including terrorist options, physical security, structural and infrastructure engineering, emergency management, and information operations. Provide career management for direct report staff. Work extended hours, outdoors, sometimes in austere conditions, and travel up to 50% of the time.
