## Plumber

Under general supervision installs, repairs, and maintains industrial piping and plumbing systems, underground utilities and facilities.

Performs new installations, daily repairs and PMS, on all types of commercial, industrial plumbing and piping systems, to include but not limited to, drainage waste and vent, domestic hot and cold water piping, non-potable water systems, underground utilities' to include water, gas and sewer mains, natural gas process piping, sprinkler piping, and other control piping related to building operations.

The ability to read and interpret blueprints, layout projects, complete material take-off, and complete projects from start to finish. Understands and works with and from work orders generated from a computerized maintenance management system (CMMS).

The knowledge and ability to use general hand tools and equipment such as electric drills, saws, sewer cleaning equipment, walk behind saws, jack hammer, and other associated tools and equipment. Familiar with and experience in working with Lock Out Tag Out systems, Hot Work Permits, and Permit Required Confined Space Permits.

Education equivalent to graduation from high school. Formal training in industrial and commercial plumbing and piping applications, such as apprenticeship program or vocational school. Mathematical knowledge for standard project calculations, such as square footage, area, volume, and total develop length for laying out and material take-off projects. Must possess a Metropolitan Government Master or Journeyman Plumbing license. Must possess a valid TN Driver's License and a clear driving history. Must obtain and maintain SIDA (Security Identification Display Area) and AOA (Airport Operations Area) clearance.

Minimum of two years' experience in repairing and installing industrial and commercial plumbing and piping systems. Leadership ability in plumbing to practice all safety rules, plan, coordinate, and install projects with little supervision.
