Dominion Generation seeks a self-motivated applicant to fill an entry-level Instrument and Control Technician position (working title Instrument Technician I) at our Possum Point Power Station.

Possum Point Power Station is a four unit power generation plant (two natural gas fired, one oil fired, and one a dual fired combined-cycle unit), located in Prince William County approximately 30 miles south of Washington D.C. in the town of Dumfries, VA (conveniently located just off of Interstate 95).

The selected candidate will:

- 1) Be responsible for assisting experienced technicians in the inspection, testing, repair, calibration, and installation of indicating, recording, and automatic control instruments such as flow meters, pressure gauges, thermometers, regulators, and similar components in a power station;
- 2) Assist with the navigation and interrogation of the Distributed Control System (DCS) using Human Machine Interface (HMI);
- 3) Be responsible for assisting in locating and reporting the cause of defective performance of instruments, and replacing component parts at the direction of the supervisor, as required;
- 4) Use portable pressure gauges, manometer, and other similar test equipment in the performance of duties;
- 5) Working under established policies and procedures, perform preventive maintenance, test flue gas, read meters, and records data as required;
- 6) Assist with the maintenance and implementation of necessary changes to drawings related to instrumentation;
- 7) Perform assignments designed to develop work knowledge, skills and abilities requiring application of policies, procedures, techniques and other criteria in carrying out all aspects of the job.

Must have availability to work overtime as required and to take 24/7 call as required. Valid driver's license required.

**Education:** High School diploma or GED required.
