BRAND NAME OR EQUAL REQUIREMENTS. The Automatic Activation Devices required are Brand Name or Equal.

The Government will evaluate all responsive offers.

EVALUATION FACTORS

The Brand Name Canopies will be evaluated solely on Price.

Automatic Activation Devices will be evaluated on Price and Technical.

BASIS FOR AWARD

Low Price for Brand Name Canopies.

Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) for Brand Name or Equal AADs.

DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE. Offerors must submit descriptive literature for "Equal" items offered. The literature must be of sufficient detail for the Government to be able to determine whether the specifications meet the requirements outlined in the RFQ.

MULTIPLE AWARDS. The Government reserves the right to issue multiple awards.

52.232-99, Providing Accelerated Payment to Small Business Subcontractors (DEVIATION 2012-00014)(August 2012)

This clause implements the temporary policy provided by OMB Policy Memorandum M-12-16, Providing Prompt Payment to Small Business Subcontractors, dated July 11, 2012.

System for Award Management Registration (August 2012)(DEVIATION)

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this clause—

“Central Contractor Registration (CCR) database” means the **retired** primary Government repository for Contractor information required for the conduct of business with the Government.

“Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code” means—

(1) A code assigned by the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Logistics Information Service to identify a commercial or Government entity; or

(2) A code assigned by a member of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization that DLA records and maintains in the CAGE master file. This type of code is known as an “NCAGE code.”

“Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number” means the 9-digit number assigned by Dun and Bradstreet, Inc. (D&B) to identify unique business entities.

“Data Universal Numbering System+4 (DUNS+4) number” means the DUNS number means the number assigned by D&B plus a 4-character suffix that may be assigned by a business concern. (D&B has no affiliation with this 4-character suffix.) This 4-character suffix may be assigned at the discretion of the business concern to establish additional **SAM** records for identifying alternative Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) accounts (see the FAR at Subpart 32.11) for the same concern.

“Registered in the **SAM** database” means that—

(1) The Contractor has entered all mandatory information, including the DUNS number or the DUNS+4 number, into the **SAM** database;

(2) The Contractor’s CAGE code is in the **SAM** database; and

(3) The Government has validated all mandatory data fields, to include validation of the Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), and has marked the record “Active”. The Contractor will be required to provide consent for TIN validation to the Government as a part of the **SAM** registration process.

“System for Award Management (SAM)” means the primary Government repository for prospective federal awardee information and the centralized Government system for certain contracting, grants, and other assistance related processes. It includes—

(1) Data collected from prospective federal awardees required for the conduct of business with the Government;

(2) Prospective contractor submitted annual representations and certifications in accordance with FAR Subpart 4.12; and

(3) The list of all parties suspended, proposed for debarment, debarred, declared ineligible, or excluded or disqualified under the nonprocurement common rule by agencies, Government corporations, or by the Government Accountability Office.

(b)(1) The **Contractor shall be registered in the SAM database prior to submitting an invoice** and through final payment of any contract, basic agreement, basic ordering agreement, or blanket purchasing agreement resulting from this solicitation.

(2) The SAM registration shall be for the same name and address identified on the contract, with its associated CAGE code and DUNS or DUNS+4.

(3) If indicated by the Government during performance, registration in an alternate system may be required in lieu of SAM.

(c) If the **Contractor** does not have a DUNS number, it should contact Dun and Bradstreet directly to obtain one.

(1) A contractor may obtain a DUNS number—

(2) The **Contractor** should be prepared to provide the following information:

(ii) Tradestyle, doing business, or other name by which your entity is commonly recognized.

(iii) Company physical street address, city, state and Zip Code.

(iv) Company mailing address, city, state and Zip Code (if separate from physical).

(v) Company telephone number.

(vi) Date the company was started.

(vii) Number of employees at your location.

(viii) Chief executive officer/key manager.

(ix) Line of business (industry).

(x) Company Headquarters name and address (reporting relationship within your entity).

(d) **Reserved.**

(e) Processing time **for registration in SAM, which normally takes five business days**, should be taken into consideration when registering. **Contractors** who are not already registered should consider applying for registration **at least two weeks prior to invoicing**.

(f) The Contractor is responsible for the accuracy and completeness of the data within the **SAM** database, and for any liability resulting from the Government's reliance on inaccurate or incomplete data. To remain registered in the **SAM** database after the initial registration, the Contractor is required to review and update on an annual basis from the date of initial registration or subsequent updates its information in the **SAM** database to ensure it is current, accurate and complete. Updating information in the **SAM** does not alter the terms and conditions of this contract and is not a substitute for a properly executed contractual document.

(g)(1)(i) If a Contractor has legally changed its business name, "doing business as" name, or division name (whichever is shown on the contract), or has transferred the assets used in performing the contract, but has not completed the necessary requirements regarding novation and change-of-name agreements in Subpart 42.12, the Contractor shall provide the responsible Contracting Officer **sufficient**

documentation to support the legally changed name with a minimum of one business day's written notification of its intention to—

- (A) Change the name in the **SAM** database;
- (B) Comply with the requirements of subpart 42.12 of the FAR; and
- (C) Agree in writing to the timeline and procedures specified by the responsible Contracting Officer.

(ii) If the Contractor fails to comply with the requirements of paragraph (g)(1)(i) of this clause, or fails to perform the agreement at paragraph (g)(1)(i)(C) of this clause, and, in the absence of a properly executed novation or change-of-name agreement, the **SAM** information that shows the Contractor to be other than the Contractor indicated in the contract will be considered to be incorrect information within the meaning of the "Suspension of Payment" paragraph of the electronic funds transfer (EFT) clause of this contract.

(2) The Contractor shall not change the name or address for EFT payments or manual payments, as appropriate, in the **SAM** record to reflect an assignee for the purpose of assignment of claims (see FAR Subpart 32.8, Assignment of Claims). Assignees shall be separately registered in the **SAM** database. Information provided to the Contractor's **SAM** record that indicates payments, including those made by EFT, to an ultimate recipient other than that Contractor will be considered to be incorrect information within the meaning of the "Suspension of payment" paragraph of the EFT clause of this contract.

This requirement is for the Brand Name purchase of non-combat-related commercial-grade canopies manufactured by Performance Designs and Cypres or Equal Automatic Activation Devices to replace those wearing/worn out for the 101st Parachute Demonstration Team (PDT), Fort Campbell, Kentucky. Required Brand Name Only models are as follows: 1 Each, Sabre 2, 9-Cell 170; 1 Each, Sabre 2, 9-Cell 150; 2 Each, Stiletto Fully Elliptical 150; 2 Each, Stiletto Fully Elliptical 135.

4. Authority:

5. Reasons for Authority Cited:

Canopies: Parachute construction has a direct effect on performance. As stated previously, these canopies will replace those wearing or worn out from use. The PDT routines and maneuvers have been designed and documented in the 101st Parachute Demonstration Team Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), using these canopy models. The canopies are nine-cell canopies. The canopy models specified, manufactured by Performance Designs, are required to meet the Government's minimum training and performance needs. There are no other known canopies that will meet the Government's minimum needs at this time.

All items in this requirement have been found to be safe as determined by the Fort Campbell Parachute Demonstration Team Safety and Training Advisor and Freefall Safety Officer.

6. Actions to Increase Competition: The Government will continue to do market research and test other canopy models and AADs to locate other potential models that perform the way the team requires, while meeting the Government's parachute safety and training standards.

7. Market Research:

(a) Prior purchase. W91248-11-P-0216 for [REDACTED] assorted parachute canopies, containers and AADs. It was procured as Brand-Name-Or-Equal.

(b) Federal supply Schedules. Not available on GSA contract.
