**POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYLS (PCBs)**

---

Polychlorinated Biphenyls, or PCBs, are a major type of toxic chemical regulated by the Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA). PCBs are most commonly found in electrical transformers and capacitors, air conditioning equipment and lighting ballasts.

All light fixture ballasts are considered to contain PCBs unless they are specifically marked "NON-PCB".

The turn-in of equipment which has, or might have, PCBs is done through the PWBC Environmental Division. To make an appointment to turn-in material containing PCBs contact the PWBC Environmental Division, Pollution Prevention Branch, building 2186, telephone 9790.
