FORT CAMPBELL MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC REGULATION

CAM Regulation 190-5, 17 February 1995, is changed as follows:

1. The material which has been added or modified by this change is indicated by an asterisk.
2. The following changes will be made:
 - * a. **Page 9, paragraph 21.** Superseded. Changed to read:

21. SKATEBOARDS. Skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, and similar devices are authorized for use on driveways, designated parking lot areas (where skateboard equipment is available), and sidewalks, but are prohibited on all roadways on the installa-

tion. Pedestrians and motor vehicles have the right of way. At a minimum, skateboarders will utilize a helmet, elbow pads and knee pads. Sponsors are responsible for the strict compliance of their family members with the provisions of this paragraph. Any person, regardless of age, using the skate ramps on Fort Campbell, for any purpose, assumes the entire risk of injury or death. Parents are responsible for supervising their minor children who use the skate ramps and assume all associated risks. The United States Government assumes no responsibility or liability to prevent injury or death to any person due to recreational use of the skate ramps on Fort Campbell.
